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HISTORY

Mormora washing station was established in 2022 and is located in a highly productive area know for its exceptional coffee quality. It sources cherries from 700-1000 farmers who travel 2-5km to deliver their harvest.

On average, these farmers own about 1.5 hectares of land and supply between 1,200kg-7000kg of cherries.

The average family size is around 7, and many farmers are able to send their children to school thanks to the income generated from coffee cherry sales.

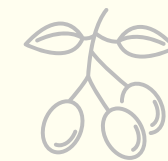
